

Business @ The Tee Golf Tournament Code of Conduct

General Conduct:

- **Respectful behavior:** Treat all participants, staff, and volunteers with courtesy and respect, regardless of their skill level or business affiliation.
- **Sportsmanship:** Play with integrity, abide by the rules of golf, and accept the results of each hole with grace.
- **Promptness:** Arrive on time for your tee time and adhere to the tournament schedule.
- **Positive attitude:** Maintain a positive and constructive demeanor throughout the event.

On the Course:

- **Pace of play:** Maintain a consistent pace and be mindful of players behind you.
- **Course etiquette:** Follow all standard golf etiquette rules, including repairing divots, replacing divots, and not walking in front of someone about to hit a shot.
- **Proper attire:** Dress appropriately for a golf tournament, including collared shirts and appropriate golf pants.
- **Penalty strokes:** Accurately report any penalty strokes incurred during play.

Business Conduct:

- **Professionalism:**

Conduct yourself in a professional manner at all times, avoiding inappropriate language or behavior.

- **No solicitation:**

Refrain from aggressively soliciting business during the tournament, unless appropriate and within the designated networking areas.

- **Confidentiality:**

Respect the privacy of other participants and refrain from sharing confidential information discussed during the event.

Safety:

- **Awareness of surroundings:**

Be aware of your surroundings on the course, including other players and carts.

- **Weather conditions:**

Be prepared for changing weather conditions and follow instructions from tournament officials regarding safety concerns.

- **Resolve issues on course:**

Attempt to resolve any disputes on the course with the involved players before escalating to tournament officials.

- **Reporting concerns:**

Report any serious issues or violations of the code of conduct to tournament organizers immediately.

Important Note:

- **Specific rules may vary:** Always consult the official tournament rules and guidelines provided by the Chamber of Commerce for any specific details or modifications to the code of conduct.

Responsible consumption Participants should drink alcohol responsibly, Participants should avoid becoming impaired or overly intoxicated, and Participants should not disrupt play.

Behavior

- Participants should not make rude or vulgar comments or gestures
- Participants should not become intoxicated
- Participants should not verbally or physically harass others
- Participants should not throw objects
- Participants should follow the instructions of tournament officials

Consequences

- Participants who are impaired or overly intoxicated may be removed from the tournament grounds
- Participants who engage in inappropriate or disruptive behavior may be required to leave the event
- Participants who become belligerent may be disqualified from the tournament
- Participants who become belligerent may have their points and position forfeited
- Participants who violate the code of conduct may face further consequences involving local law enforcement

Property Damage

- Participants will be held liable for any damage to property, including golf carts, buildings, signs, landscape or greens
