Core Curriculum

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Title of Lesson: Habit 6: Synergize; Together is Better

Domain: Academic/ Social Emotional

Grade Level- K-5 Time Required: 40 minutes

Materials/Resources:

Solo cups

Yarn

Rubber bands

The Power of teamwork video

Minion Teamwork short film

Activity: Begin the lesson with minion video and allow the students to guess the topic: Synergize: teamwork. Discuss the pros/cons of working as a team. What are skills that are necessary for successful team work? Read the book, The Little Red Pen. Discuss how the downfall that occurred when the characters did not work as a team? How did the bool turn around when they decided to work successfully? Was communication important? What other skills did you see in the book? Did the characters use their strengths to help others? Next, the students will be broken into groups of 4 to participate in a team work activity. Each group will be given 6 solo cups and a rubber band with 4 pieces of yarn tied to the rubber band. The goal of the group is to successfully stack the solo cups in a pyramid without touching the cups with their hands. They may only manipulate the cups with the rubber band and yarn. The students will work as team to make the pyramid. After each team is successful, gather back as a group and reflect on the activity. Were you successful? Why? Why not? What skills were necessary to be successful? Were there any problems? If so, how did you solve them as team? Finish with watching The Power of Teamwork video.

Evaluation: Evaluate the students during the group activity. Are the students applying the necessary skills to be successful? Were the teams successful?
