### **Conference Presentations:**

- <u>ECP (Cyprus: July, 2025):</u> Currently, our main focus is the Division 17 Symposium: "International Perspectives on Psychologists in Integrated Health Care: Equitable, Accessible and Innovative Models" (LINK to the abstract) we are running at the European Congress of Psychology 3.00pm on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July.
  - Our symposium focuses on the role of psychologists in integrated health care, with our group representing international leaders from different psychological associations and countries around the world. We have been collaborating in this area of work since 2010 through the Division 17 of Professional Practice, convening yearly symposia at international Conferences (ICAP, ICP and ECP) to showcase our ongoing work. The symposium represents state of the art topics from different international perspectives.
- ICAP (Florence: July, 2026): we have submitted ideas for keynote speakers, invited symposia and other papers to the IAAP Executive for the Florence ICAP program and are well-advanced in finalising our ideas for this.

#### Monthly Executive Committee Zoom meetings:

We continue to meet monthly by zoom, with a growing membership now including members from Argentina, Ireland, Japan as well as the USA, Australia, Rwanda and India. Our June meeting is to be held on 24<sup>th</sup>/25<sup>th</sup> June, spanning multiple time zones.

Our focus is on latest topics relevant to the profession of psychology around the world – e.g. the revision and re-design of training pathways in Psychology in Australia; the move to registration of the profession in Ireland, etc. ...
