



From September 2nd to 6th, 2024, Leipzig University in Germany hosted the PhD course titled <u>Research Methods</u>. <u>Publication Strategies</u>. <u>and Career Perspectives in Sport Psychology</u>. IAAP members were involved in this international event, which brought together early-career researchers from 11 universities and 10 nationalities.

Participants gained personalized feedback on their research and explored career paths in sport psychology. The course also fostered valuable professional relationships through social events and interactions with peers and experts, paving the way for future collaborations. The experience was both academically enriching and socially rewarding, making it highly recommended for PhD students.
