

The project titled *Bersilaturahim on a trans-national level: A participatory action research project for developing trans-affirming elderly care services in Indonesia and Malaysia* by **Andrian Liem**, PhD (The University of Queensland), Research Fellow at Jeffrey Cheah School of Medicine and Health Sciences, Monash University Malaysia, was announced as one of the recipients of the Global LGBTI Aging Small Grants Program from The Williams Institute - UCLA Law School and SAGE's. The project aimed to connect and unite all stakeholders (academics, professionals, and trans communities) in Indonesia and Malaysia for developing trans-affirming elderly care services through participatory methods and a knowledge exchange process between the aforementioned parties. 
