

IASPA: Shelli Anderson Legacy Award for Excellence in School Law

The Shelli Anderson Legacy Award for Excellence in School Law is given to an education law attorney for their exceptional dedication and service to their school district clients. The recipient exhibits one or more of the following serves as an example, through their record of exceptional leadership and dedication, of excellence in the practice of law; exceptional dedication to their profession and clients through excellent communication, timely responses and support, and the highest level of service; significant contribution(s) to their clients' organization; forward thinking training & support for human resource leaders that is above and beyond the norm. Documentation for each category is required.
