PROMPTING WITH PURPOSE: HOW TO GET BETTER RESULTS FROM AI TOOLS

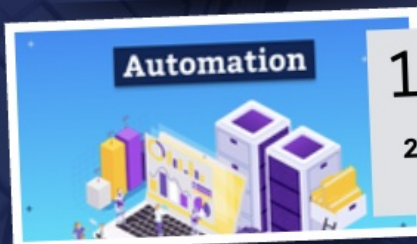
