Distinguished Service Award

Distinguished Service Awards are presented to individuals who have made substantial contributions to IASPA, advancing or enhancing the professional visibility of the association and its purpose and/or the field of school personnel administration.

The Distinguished Service Award is presented to Ray Chung, Chief Legal Officer in Niles High School District 219. Mr. Chung leads IASPA's Constitution/Bylaws & Governmental Relations work. In this role, he is consulted and advises on legislative changes being proposed at the state level. In addition to his work as a member of IASPA's Board, Mr. Chung has provided resources and support to HR and school law colleagues.

In District 219, Mr. Chung presented on recruitment practices, retention practices, and data oversight. He leads the development of racial equity and anti-racist Board policies while supporting the HR and Equity Departments.
