- 9. Develop program newsletters and written communications, which provide updated information about the program. Provide gifted education information for the district web page.

- 10. Participate in course work addressing the social, emotional, and academic needs of the gifted, talented or students ready for accelerated learning.
- 11. Maintain high expectations for student directed learning.
- 12. Participate in appropriate professional development as approved or assigned by the Assistant Superintendent for Educational Achievement. Conduct personal continuous professional development by continual reading of professional books, journals and other literature regarding gifted, talented or students ready for accelerated learning.
