Supervises the arrival and departure of assigned students each day, as directed by the physical education teacher or Building Principal.

Escorts students to and from washroom, classrooms, or other locations on or off school premises, as assigned by the physical education teacher or Building Principal.

Assist with the behavioral management system of students, as assigned by the physical education teacher or Building Principal.

Assist in the preparation of instructional materials, construction and/or room displays, as assigned by the physical education teacher or Building Principal.

Performs other tasks and assumes such other responsibilities as may be assigned from time to time.
