

The Family Recovers - Leigh H.

There was a time in my life when I was completely unaware that the generational codependency on my maternal side was unusual, or that it didn't contribute to healthy relationships. I adored my great grandmother (who had very restrictive ideas regarding bad language, drinking, religion and sex that she quite vocally shared), was less close to her daughter, my grandmother (who tried to restrict drug and alcohol consumption in both of her husbands over the years), and my mother (who finessed passive aggressiveness to try to make my father control his overeating, but rarely responded

to his anger or criticism with any assertiveness of her own). There definitely were good moments in each relationship as I observed them over the years, but unhealthy communication is what I learned and brought into my marriage.


