

IDAA Recovery Story

Embracing the Journey - Fran L.


Recognizing the phone number of my attorney I quickly picked up the call during a busy workday ten years ago. "Fran, the state has issued an emergency suspension of your license." Out of all the consequences of my addiction that was the one that had never occurred to me. Three years previously when I was "12th Stepped" by the DEA showing up at my home, I promptly went to (my second) 90-day treatment, signed up for the PHP and monitoring, completed Aftercare, and was diligent about ten to twelve AA meetings

weekly. One attorney had carefully unwound the DEA's concerns, and I had recrafted my life in recovery, for two years working at my favorite job in a long career. I told my lawyer, "I have thirteen patients on ventilators, what do I tell them at work?"

My attorney uttered the words that saved my life over the next long painful stretch. "It will never get worse than right now." Somehow that was consoling. If I could just get through the next few conversations, things would begin to get better. She gave me some words to tell the CMO ("I don't know what's happening right now, but the state

has suspended my license.") and I called in the back-up physician.
