Through multi-million-dollar federal grants, he expands access to care, recovery housing, and harm reduction initiatives, focusing on unsheltered and justice-involved populations. Combining clinical expertise, education, community leadership, and lived experience, Dr. Richardson drives transformative improvements in healthcare access across North Carolina.
