Dr. Rehmann received his bachelor of science degree in biochemistry at Azusa Pacific University. He then went

to the University of Vermont College of Medicine and completed his internship and residency at St. Mary's Medical Center in Evansville Indiana. Dr. Rehmann holds two board certifications in both addiction medicine as well as family medicine. He previously worked as a private practice family physician for 20 years in Spokane, Washington with a wide scope of practice from labor and delivery to end of life care. He transitioned to full-time addiction medicine at Sundown M Ranch in 2019 where he sees every patient that comes in and actively manages their withdrawal. Dr. Rehmann is a fellow of the American Society of Addiction Medicine and helped write the withdrawal management in the ASAM criteria fourth edition. Dr. Rehmann has a passion for helping every patient he meets find recovery. As part of his passion for recovery he enjoys teaching medical students as well as PA students who come to the Treatment Center to learn about addiction and the path to recovery. Dr. Rehmann is a firm believer in the 12 steps of AA/NA and uses medication as an adjunct to achieve this goal.
