

PHASE TWO FLORIDA SAFE.SMART.STEP-BY-STEP EFFECTIVE 6/5/2020
APPLIES TO ALL COUNTIES IN FLORIDA EXCEPT MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD
AND PALM BEACH - NEW LOOSENING OF RESTRICTIONS

VISITS TO SENIOR CARE FACILITIES AND HOSPITALS should be prohibited. Those who do interact with residents and patients must adhere to strict protocols regarding hygiene.

ENTERTAINMENT AND LARGE VENUES (e.g., sit-down dining, movie theaters, sporting venues, may operate at 50 % capacity can operate under appropriate physical distancing protocols and sanitation.

ELECTIVE SURGERIES can resume, as clinically appropriate, on an outpatient and in-patient basis at facilities that adhere to CMS guidelines.

GYMS can remain open if they adhere to strict physical distancing and sanitation protocols.

BARS may operate with diminished standing-room occupancy, where applicable and appropriate.

RETAIL may operate at full capacity with responsible social distancing and sanitation protocols

PARI-MUTUAL FACILITIES may submit a request to open to DBPR and must include an endorsement from their county mayor or county administrator if there is no mayor

PERSONAL SERVICES BUSINESSES SUCH AS MASSAGE OR ACUPUNCTURE may operate while adhering to guidance from the Florida Department of Health.

All Persons in Florida are *encouraged* to avoid congregating in groups larger than 50 people

Some restrictions still apply to people traveling in from New York and its Tri State area.
