Track Descriptions

Operational Excellence: Tools and Strategies for Running a Successful ESO	This track will cover the nuts and bolts of running an entrepreneur support organization (ESO), from structuring and running effective programs to working with stakeholders to managing a facility to measuring impact and more. These sessions will explore the elements and strategies for building successful entrepreneurship ecosystems in any community.

The sessions in this track will highlight these current trends and also look at programs that focus specifically on one area or demographic.
