


# THE LEONARD FRENKIL, JR. SCHOLARSHIP FUND

## **LEONARD FRENKIL, JR. SCHOLARSHIP FUND**

The IREM Maryland Chapter 16 Leonard Frenkil, Jr. Scholarship Fund has been established to help those candidates of the chapter that are experiencing financial hardship or lack of financial support from their employer.

### **Leonard Frenkil, Jr. Scholarship Fund Educational Scholarship Program**

The fund will provide up to \$2000 per applicant to cover the costs of IREM Region 3 IREM CPM® Capstone and Certification exam. The Scholarship is open to all ARM®, ACoM, CPM® Candidates, Associate Members, and Student Members in good standing.

### **Criteria and Procedures**

#### Administration and Authority to Confer

The Executive Council of IREM Maryland Chapter 16 conducts the administration of this program. It has complete and final authority to confer or revoke scholarships and to make other decisions pertaining to the use of funds in the scholarship program.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

All Applicants must:

- Be a US Citizen or be able to legally work in the US.
- Be a current candidate of Maryland Chapter 16 in good standing.
- Complete the official application form.
- Write a personal letter (email is acceptable) that clearly states the applicant's career objectives and how the scholarship will help the applicant reach those goals.
- Be interviewed by two members of the Executive Committee.
- Agree to participate on a committee of the EC's choice for a minimum of one year upon receipt of the scholarship.

Only one award will be given per applicant, per calendar year. The IREM Maryland Chapter 16 Leonard Frenkil, Jr. Scholarship Fund award is subject to funds available at the time of the application.
