## **Consumer Notification of Service Line Materials**

The federal Lead and Copper Rule (Revisions) (40 CFR 141, Subpart I) requires all water systems with lead, galvanized requiring replacement (GRR), or lead status unknown service lines in their inventory to inform all persons served by the water system at the service connection with a lead, GRR, or lead status unknown service line.

What to submit to KY Division of Water: This document, along with a copy of the notification(s) provided to the customer, must be submitted to the Division of Water by July 1, 2025. Water Systems are encouraged to submit the certification document as soon as notifications are complete. Water Systems are not required to use this form; it is provided for convenience. Systems may submit other forms prepared by other entities or a letter, as long as the required information is included.

To submit, you may mail the documents, or upload to EEC eForm 169: Drinking Water Information and Data Submittal.
