Carlisle County

The State of Missouri, just across the Mississippi River forms the western boundary of Carlisle County. The county was formed from Ballard County land in 1886. This area is known as the Purchase area. The county seat is at Bardwell.

John Griffin Carlisle was born in what is now Kenton County in 1835. By the time he was fifteen years old he was teaching school. After moving to Covington to study law, he was admitted to the bar in 1858. In succession Carlisle was elected to the state legislature, then the senate and finally lleutenant-governor. In 1877 he served in the U.S. House of Representatives and within six years became Speaker of the House. In 1893 Carlisle became Secretary of the Treasury. He died in 1910.

Arlington Water and Sewer Wellhead Protection Areas






