Reporting a Cluster to Mass DPH and local board of health	3 or more influenza-like illnesses (ILI*). A new form should only be submitted if there is a new cluster and it has been greater than 14 days since your last case. (*ILI is defined as: Fever of $\geq 100^{\circ}\text{F}$ and cough and/or sore throat.).
