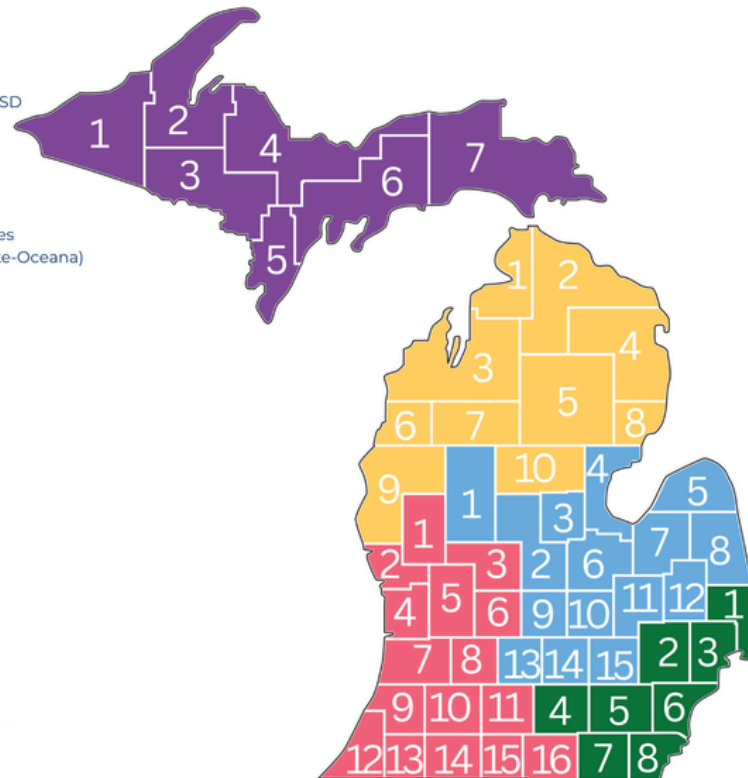

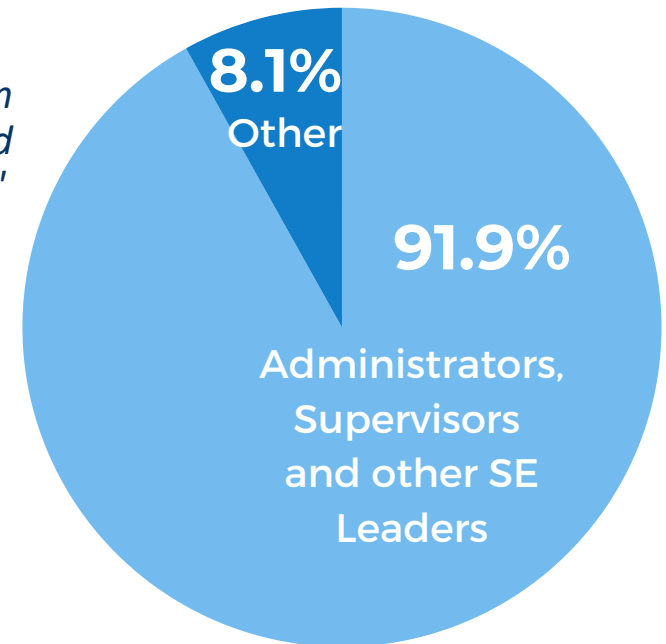
About the Attendees
