Adaptive Schools Foundation Seminar

Dates: September 29-30, 2025 and March 2-3, 2026:

Description: The Adaptive Schools Foundation Seminar presents a productive, practical set of ideas and tools to develop collaborative groups to become effective and better equipped to resolve complex student learning issues. The work of the Adaptive Schools Seminars is to develop the resources and capacities of the organization and of individuals to cohesively respond to the changing needs of students and society. In this four-day Adaptive Schools Training, participants will develop:

- An increased capacity to initiate, develop and sustain high-functioning groups
- New lenses for diagnosing the stages and phases of group development
- An expanded repertoire of practical facilitation tools
- An understanding of when and how to engage groups in dialogue and discussion, the limitations, forms and values of each
- Skills to move groups beyond consensus to common focus
- Ways to value and use dissension, argument and conflict
- Strategies for keeping group members on track, on topic, energized and resourceful





Instructional Leadership for Inclusive Excellence: Strengthening Systems for All Learners

Description: John O'Connor is a nationally recognized special education leader with over 30 years of experience improving instructional systems at the school, district, and state levels. As the author of Great Instruction, Great Achievement for Students with Disabilities, he offers practical, research-based strategies to strengthen outcomes for all learners. This session will include topics such as instructional improvement, effective co-teaching, developing master schedules that support inclusive practices, and improving instruction in the least restrictive environment. Participants will also explore how to build an instructionally focused special education department and implement Michigan's new dyslexia laws to ensure access and success for all learners. Dates: October 15, 2025, December 3, 2025, February 11, 2026, April 15, 2026, & June 9, 2026



SLIP (Supervisors of Low Incidence Population) Winter Conference Dates: January 12-13, 2026




