

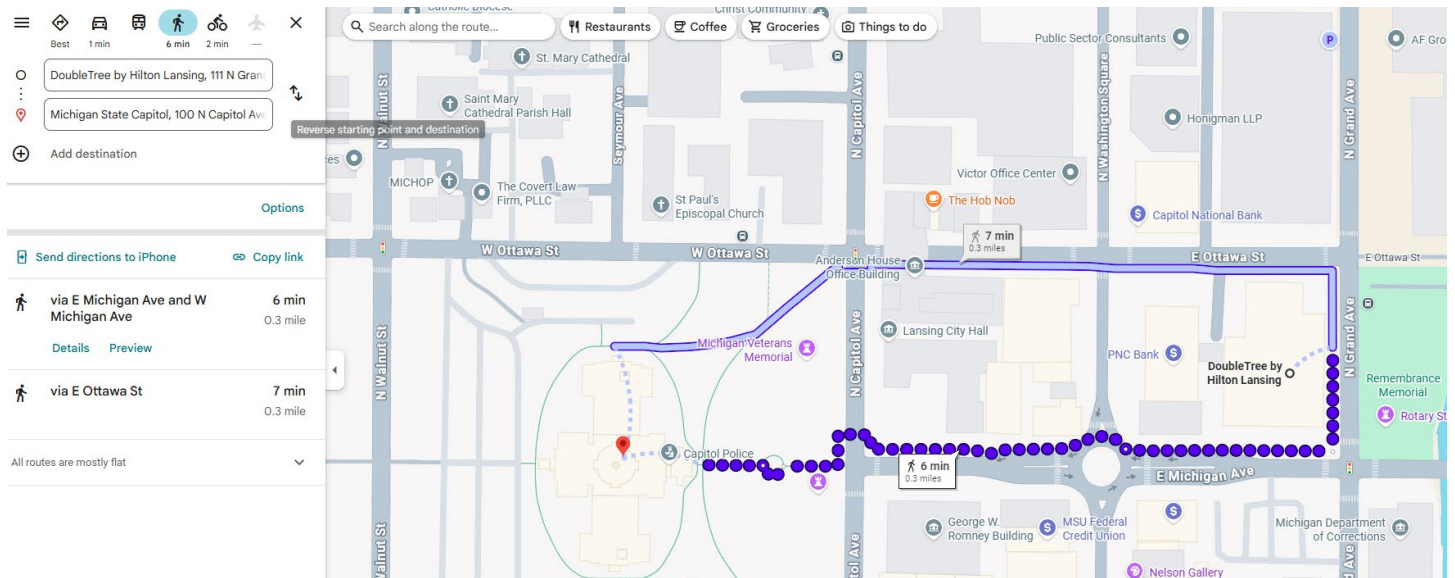

Parking

There is a self-parking structure for approximately \$15.00/day in the adjacent city-owned North Grand Parking Ramp (219 N Grand Ave, Lansing, MI 48933 / Enter off of N. Grand Ave or E. Ionia St.) which connects to the hotel via a skywalk on the third level. Please bring your ticket inside to pay that the stations. You can also park using hotel valet as well (cost is typically \$32-35/day).
