Planning for a Biden Administration

The debate rages on as to who won the presidential election in November. Putting aside politics and the arguments as to who won, those working in the construction industry need to start thinking about how things will change if former Vice President Joe Biden is sworn into office on January 20, 2021. Using President Trump's current policies as the baseline, the following things are certainly possibilities that will directly impact the construction industry:

- 1. Higher taxes. Vice President Biden has pledged to raise taxes in multiple ways. He will certainly push for an increase in the corporate tax rate and his policy of taxing upper income individuals will hurt business owners who file as S-Corporations. Republican wins in the run-off elections for U.S. Senate in Georgia could stymie tax increases; but if presented with an opportunity, taxes will go up.
- 2. Increased regulation. President Trump eliminated more government regulations than any recent president. Less regulations means less compliance obligations overall. While regulations are not always bad as a general proposition, they generally impose less efficiency and more cost in the construction industry. Vice President Biden foreshadowed more regulations during the campaign; and history generally supports more regulation when a Democrat is in the White House.



Participate in Air Leakage Testing!

To increase energy conservation, energy codes and standards have been stepping up the effort to reduce air leakage, moving toward a requirement for whole building tests to ensure an adequate air barrier in addition to, or in place of, the prescriptive requirements for materials and assemblies.

In order to help prepare builders, contractors, and erectors for upcoming code requirements, the Metal Building Manufacturers Association (MBMA) is performing these tests and developing a best practice guide. Four buildings have been tested to date and more are needed with the following characteristics:

- Plan area of 5,000 to 20,000 ft².
- · Conditioned interior space.
- Compliant with 2012 IECC or ASHRAE 90.1-2013 or later editions.
- Lower U-value / higher R-value insulation systems, such as filled cavity, rigid board continuous insulation, insulated metal panels, and spray foam insulation.
