



WORKER MISCLASSIFICATION: ARE YOU READY FOR ANTICIPATED CHANGES IN REGULATION AND ENFORCEMENT?

The labor shortage caused by the 'great resignation' has impacted the construction industry and given rise to a greater 'gig economy'. With a number of states increasing their enforcement and focus on worker misclassification, employers in the construction industry should take steps to avoid misclassifying members of their labor force as independent contractors. Pennsylvania's Worker Misclassification Task Force is set to provide a final report in December 2022 with a number of recommendations for legislative action in this area that will greatly impact employers in the construction industry and beyond.

In March, the Task Force released a preliminary report that provided a preview of what employers can expect in the area of increased worker misclassification enforcement and regulation. This preview should be used as an opportunity to start a 'best practices' review to ensure compliance and mitigate any risk of liability for worker misclassification.
