The following is a quick summary of the 2025 MBCEA Strategic Retreat, and a thank you to all your Chapter Presidents, your Executive Committee, and your Board, for their time, and their courage to speak up for what is working, and as importantly, that which is not.

Here's a higher-level look at what we did. If none of the roles, or the people, sound familiar, call me; I will be happy to share more!

Of the Members on The Executive Committee and The Board, we asked each to complete a priority map, that listed categories: Organization, Finance, Accreditation, Membership, Apprenticeship, Chapters and Collaboration with the Metal Building Manufacturers Association (MBMA). With additional guidance from David Leinbach (MBCEA Vice President) and Sasha Demyan; the priority map included a priority algorithm. This mapping guided the conversations and will ultimately prioritize programs that deliver the most value such as safety training, accreditation (like AC478), and financial stability. On the other hand, it makes us aware of overextending into unfamiliar areas during potential volatile periods.

Each category and its scores were evaluated for potential and vulnerabilities, identifying which programs are essential and those which may be paused, or dare I say it, sunset.



# Technical Corner: Reviewing Specifications and Contract Requirements

Before mobilizing to a project, every builder or erector should take time to review the specifications and contract language—not just the drawings. Many projects include testing, inspection, and reporting requirements that can fall on the installer if not clearly excluded. Items such as bolt tension verification, weld inspection, anchor pull testing, or water and air infiltration testing are often buried within Division 01, 05 or 13 specifications. Just as important, the structural notes on the design drawings frequently outline inspection and testing criteria that may be assigned to the contractor of record and be pushed down to the erector. If your proposal or contract doesn't specifically exclude these responsibilities, you may be held accountable for their cost and coordination.

Understanding who owns these tasks—testing agencies, the general contractor, or the erector—is critical. Clear communication during preconstruction ensures that all parties share the same expectations before work begins. The takeaway: review the structural notes, specification sections, and referenced standards carefully; document exclusions in writing; and confirm testing responsibilities early. A short review at bid time can prevent expensive misunderstandings once the steel starts going up.
