We also collaborated with the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences (NIEHS) National Clearinghouse to create a Disaster Preparedness App (available on <u>Google</u> and <u>Apple</u>) that provides easy access to training tools and health and safety guidance for those involved in disaster response and cleanup activities following a variety of catastrophic events.
