PATROL — Peace officer Accredited TRaining OnLine — empowers peace officers in Minnesota to earn POST credits online anytime, anywhere.

PATROL courses ensure officers stay current on best practices and state legal requirements with content developed by police liability experts, insurance defense attorneys, and local law enforcement agencies.

All courses are approved for one POST credit, and a new course is added every month!

Training categories include:

- Use of force
- Autism
- Crisis intervention/mental illness crisis
- Conflict management and mediation
- Implicit bias, community diversity and cultural differences
- OSHA standards
- Critical knowledge
- Management and leadership
