Note regarding Reasonable Accommodations/Modifications

Not Reasonable

Accommodation/modification

- Separate concepts/legal authorities
 - RA/RM is specific request for changes to policies/unit (or related areas) made by disabled person.
 - D & C requirements apply to all covered units at construction (not requested by tenant)

Covered Dwelling Units

- The D & C requirements apply to:
 - "Covered multifamily dwellings"
 - Designed and constructed for 1st occupancy after
 March 13, 1991
- Covered Multifamily Dwellings Include:
 - <u>Elevator</u> = All dwelling units in buildings containing four or more units
 - No Elevator = All ground floor units in buildings containing four or more units
 - FYI Can have more than one ground floor.



- 1 <u>Accessible</u> Building Entrance on an Accessible Route
- 2 <u>Accessible</u> and <u>Usable</u> Public and Common Use Areas
- 3 <u>Usable</u> Doors
- 4 <u>Accessible</u> Route into and Through the Covered Unit
- 5 Light Switches, Electrical Outlets, Thermostats, & Other Environmental Controls in <u>Accessible</u> Locations
- 6 Reinforced Walls for Grab Bars
- 7 <u>Usable</u> Kitchens and Bathrooms
