Meeting Space

We propose hosting the Spring Meeting at the Greater Des Moines Botanical Garden. Unique, beautiful, and always in bloom, the Greater Des Moines Botanical Garden has an indoor space full of tropical plants, wandering paths, waterfalls, and quiet benches. Outdoors, the extensive gardens include a notable bonsai collection, a water garden, and a thriving and adventurous palette of thousands of plants. Trellis Cafe offers a fresh seasonal menu to highlight plant inspired items, run by chef/owner Lisa LaValle, a longtime star on the Des Moines food scene.





The Botanical Garden offers several meeting spaces, including rooms that can accommodate 10-50 participants and rooms that can accommodate up to 100 participants. These range in price from \$400-\$900 per day. The price includes complimentary admission to the Garden for event guests, tables and linens, set-up and tear down, free parking and free Wi-Fi. All food and beverages must be purchased through approved caterers, including the onsite Trellis Cafe.

Lodging

The AC Hotel is located within walking distance of the Greater Des Moines Botanical Garden and is situated in Des Moines' East Village, a vibrant neighborhood with lots to do and enjoy (including Storyhouse Bookpub!) Regular room rates are typically \$150-\$200/night, but the hotel does offer a group rate. There are also many other lodging options in the area including Embassy Suites and Staybridge Suites, both with rates similar to the AC Hotel.
