2025 program details

This course is intended for individuals who are not lineworkers who might be called into service to work alongside a qualified line worker (i.e., during an outage or other emergencies). Regardless of the lay employee's role, it is crucial that they be sufficiently trained.

Course content

Cross Training provides fundamental "basic training" for utility personnel. Participants can increase their knowledge of lineworker tools/equipment, broaden their understanding of electricity and the hazards, and increase confidence in their ability to assist.

All topics are taught at a basic level and may include:

- Introduction to powerline training
- Personal and job safety
- Basic electrical theory
- Overhead and underground construction
- Grounding, rope, rigging
- · Meters and meter safety
- Distribution transformers and equipment
- Troubleshooting primary and secondary
- Basic chainsaw safety
- · Generator backfeed precautions
- · Bucket truck operation

- High-visibility clothing/ outerwear
- Safety glasses
- Work gloves
- Hard hat
- Safety footwear
- Notebook and pen/pencil
