This year's workshop will be led by Mike Miller, safety director with the Electric Association who will cover topics that benefit non-electricians to further develop skills and increase confidence to work safely in a water/ wastewater environment.

Plus, there will be plenty of hands-on exercises covering everything from the basics of operating a voltmeter to more challenging troubleshooting on various electrical equipment.
