

Common Analgesic/Pain Medications

Opioids

Uses: moderate/severe pain, chronic pain, detoxification (methadone only)

Side effects: constipation, dry mouth, nausea, vomiting, respiratory depression, QT prolongation

DDIs: MAOIs, CNS depressants, amiodarone, azole antifungals

Pregnancy Category: Oxycodone is category B, all others are C

Codeine (contained in Tylenol #3)	Tablet, solution
Fentanyl (Duragesic)	Solution, tablet, lozenge, patch
Hydrocodone (in Lortab, Norco, Vicodin)	Tablet, solution, capsule
Hydromorphone (Dilaudid)	Tablet, solution, suppository, extended release tablet
Methadone	Tablet, solution, concentrate
Meperidine (Demerol)	Tablet, solution
Oxycodone (Oxycontin)	Tablet, capsule, solution, extended release tablet
Oxymorphone (Opana)	Tablet, solution, extended release tablet
Tramadol (Ultram)	Tablet, extended release capsule, extended release tablet, suspension

Nonsteroidal Anti-inflammatory agents (NSAIDs)

Uses: mild/moderate pain, osteoarthritis, rheumatoid arthritis

Side effects: GI bleeding, dizziness, nausea, diarrhea, bloating

DDIs: ACE inhibitors, alcohol, anticoagulants

Pregnancy Category: celecoxib, diclofenac, meloxicam are category D, all others are C

Uses: neuropathic pain

Side effects: dizziness, fatigue, somnolence, suicidal ideation, respiratory depression with lidocaine

Pregnancy Category: Lidocaine is category B, the rest are all C
