I am hopefully optimistic that over the next few years our downtown will rebuild and obtain the crown it once held as the place to be. When it does, we can be certain that restaurants will be part of the plan. Restaurants are the cornerstone in every community. Our residents dine with us for a variety of reasons. Something quick to go, like a place to meet friends and family, or on a special day celebrate an occasion. In STL we have over 1900 restaurants and employee more than 35,000 hard-working individuals.

Restaurants are the industry of opportunity. If you are willing to show up on time, and ready to work, you can move up the ladder quickly. We have countless stories of individuals entering the workforce as a dishwasher or bus boy and after a few years of hard work end up as the general manager, chef, or owner. Along the way the GSTLRA and its members have provided opportunities for scholarships, education, networking, and mentoring.

I am often asked why I should join the Restaurant Association. My answer varies with the conversation, but the most important reason is our advocacy. The Restaurant Associations is constantly working to protect business owners' rights. We are the only organization completely dedicated to your success. Recently in STL we testified to stop BB104 which would have legislated businesses must provide 2 weeks advance scheduling and pay employees for cancelled shifts. In Jefferson City we are working to strengthen our preemption law by adding scheduling and paid time off to the definitions that municipalities cannot regulate, helping to create an even playing field across the state.

On the Federal level, a delegation met with our Congressman and Senators to educate them on the importance of tax incentives, bonus depreciation, preserving the tip server credit, passage of the Credit Card Protection Act (CCCA) and opposition to an FTC rule banning surcharges. Tomorrow we will face additional challenges, but you can rest assured the MRA will be there to support our industry.

There are many other benefits to becoming a member, including member discounts & rebates on purchase, networking and collaborating with like-minded operators to exchange ideas that strengthen our industry.

The Missouri Restaurant Association is growing and STL is a major focus with its high concentration of great restaurants. I encourage you all to become involved in the GSTLRA Board of Directors and contribute to our investment in the community.
