

Mastering the Sanitary Survey

This class will provide information on how to prepare yourself and your system for that upcoming sanitary survey. This course covers the components of the sanitary survey, and what you need to look for prior to the inspection. It also addresses which records should be made available to the regulator who will be performing the survey.

Learning Outcomes: Each attendee will be informed with the basic knowledge requirements associated with their community participating in a Sanitary Survey. For officials attending it provides an open forum to add information in a state-by-state requirement of what information and documents they will be requesting to review for completing that states Sanitary Survey.

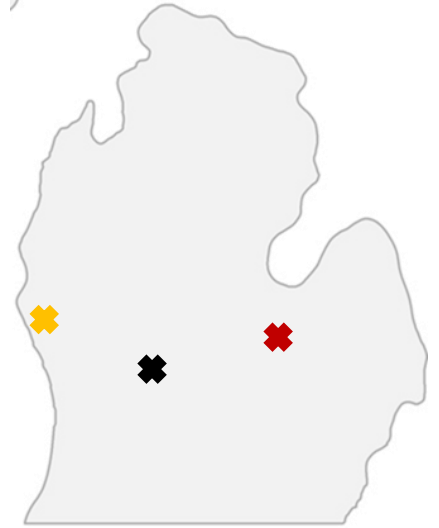
