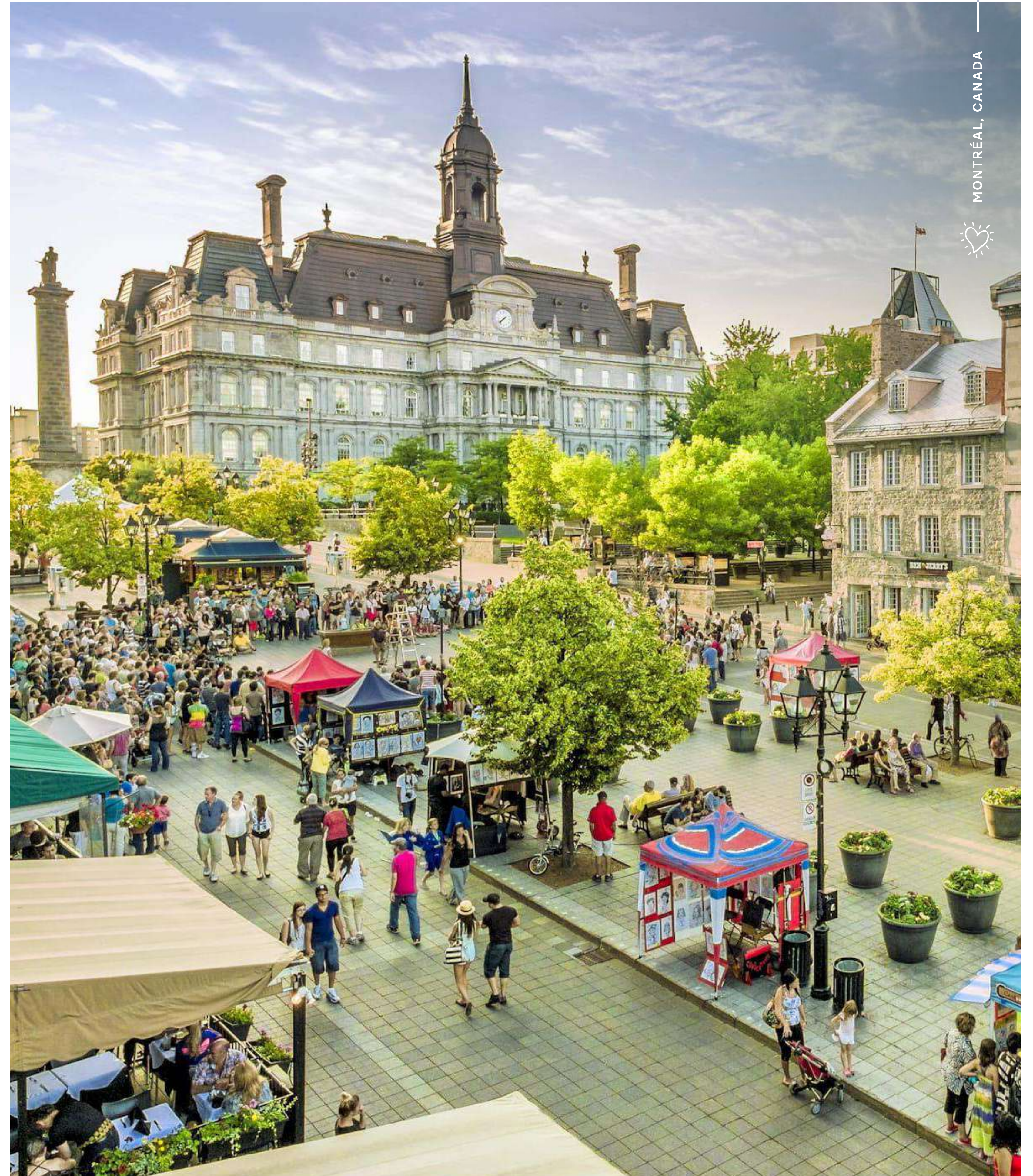
How to Get Around

◆ **Club Chasse et Pêche**

Michelin-recommended and discreetly tucked away in Old Montréal, this moody, upscale hideaway serves luxurious meat and seafood dishes with bold, refined flair.

◆ **Gibby's**

Housed in a 200-year-old stone building in Old Montréal, Gibby's elevates the classic steakhouse experience with timeless elegance, exceptional cuts, and a warm, historic ambiance.

◆ **Le Monarque**

One of the city's most popular restaurants, sleek and sophisticated Le Monarque offers both brasserie and fine dining menus, with polished French-inspired cuisine in a stunning industrial space.



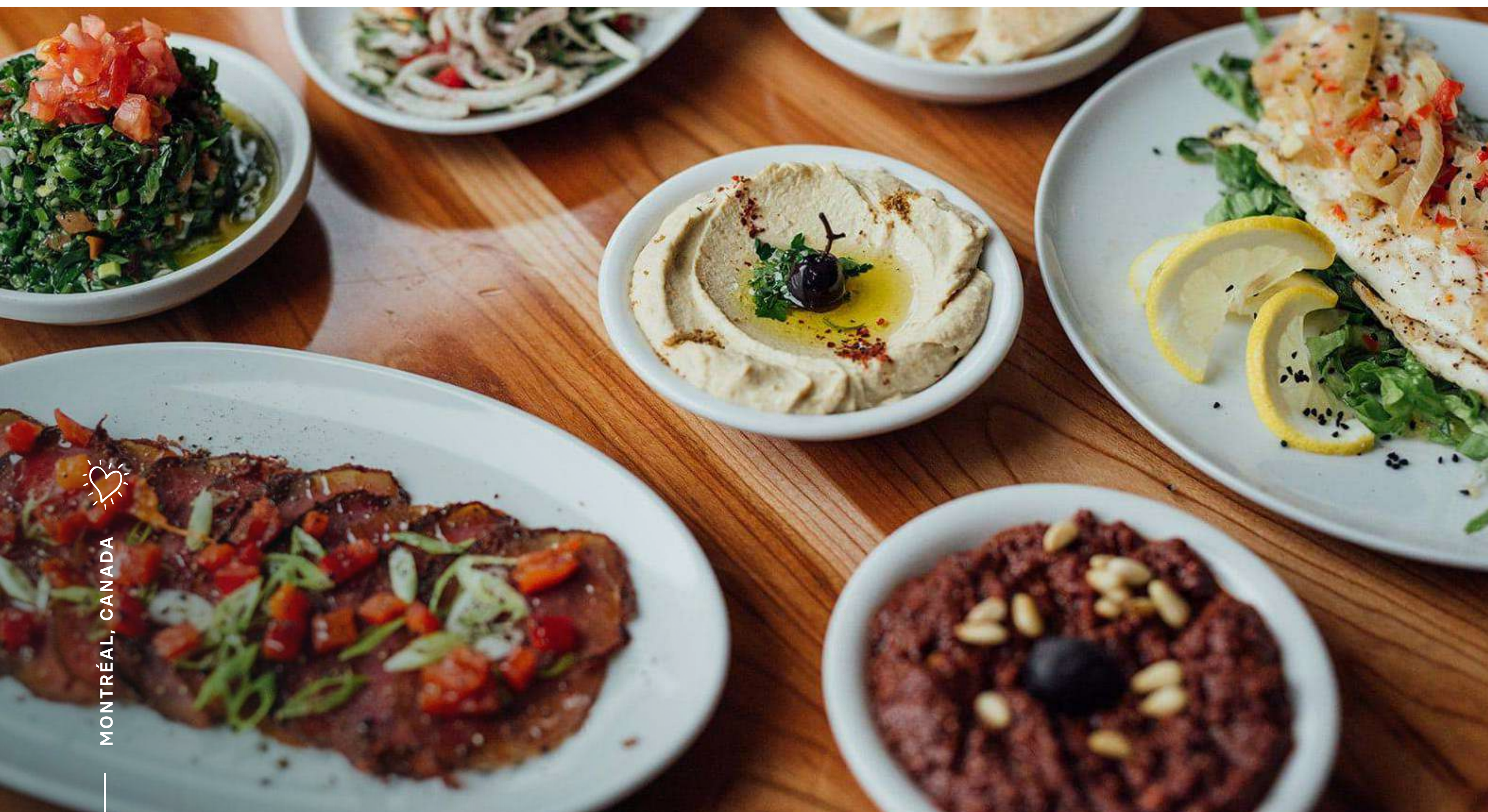
Recommended Casual Dining

◆ Joe Beef

Renowned for its indulgent Québécois-French cuisine and unpretentious charm, this culinary gem offers a rich, ever-changing menu in a cozy, eclectic setting.

◆ Le Petit Alep

A Michelin Bib Gourmand pick, this beloved Syrian-Armenian spot serves bold, flavor-rich dishes in a vibrant, unpretentious setting worth the trip uptown.



◆ Schwartz's Deli

This legendary deli has been serving its world-famous smoked meat sandwiches since 1928, drawing crowds with its old-school charm and time-honored recipes.

◆ Olive + Gourmando

Steps from historic Old Montréal, this beloved café-restaurant is famous for house-made breads, paninis, pastries, and creative daytime dishes that balance comforting classics with inventive twists.

◆ St-Viateur Bagel

A Montréal icon since 1957, St-Viateur hand-rolls and wood-fires its legendary bagels to perfection—chewy, slightly sweet, and always worth the visit.

Recommended Activities & Attractions

◆ The Old Port/Le Vieux Port

Ride the Ferris Wheel, sample local food trucks, and stroll the scenic waterfront boardwalk. From the International Fireworks Festival to the IMAX Science Center, this historic destination has it all.

◆ Saint Joseph's Oratory

Perched atop the majestic Mount Royal Park, this grand basilica and pilgrimage site is an architectural marvel, offering serene gardens and panoramic city views.

◆ Cirque du Soleil

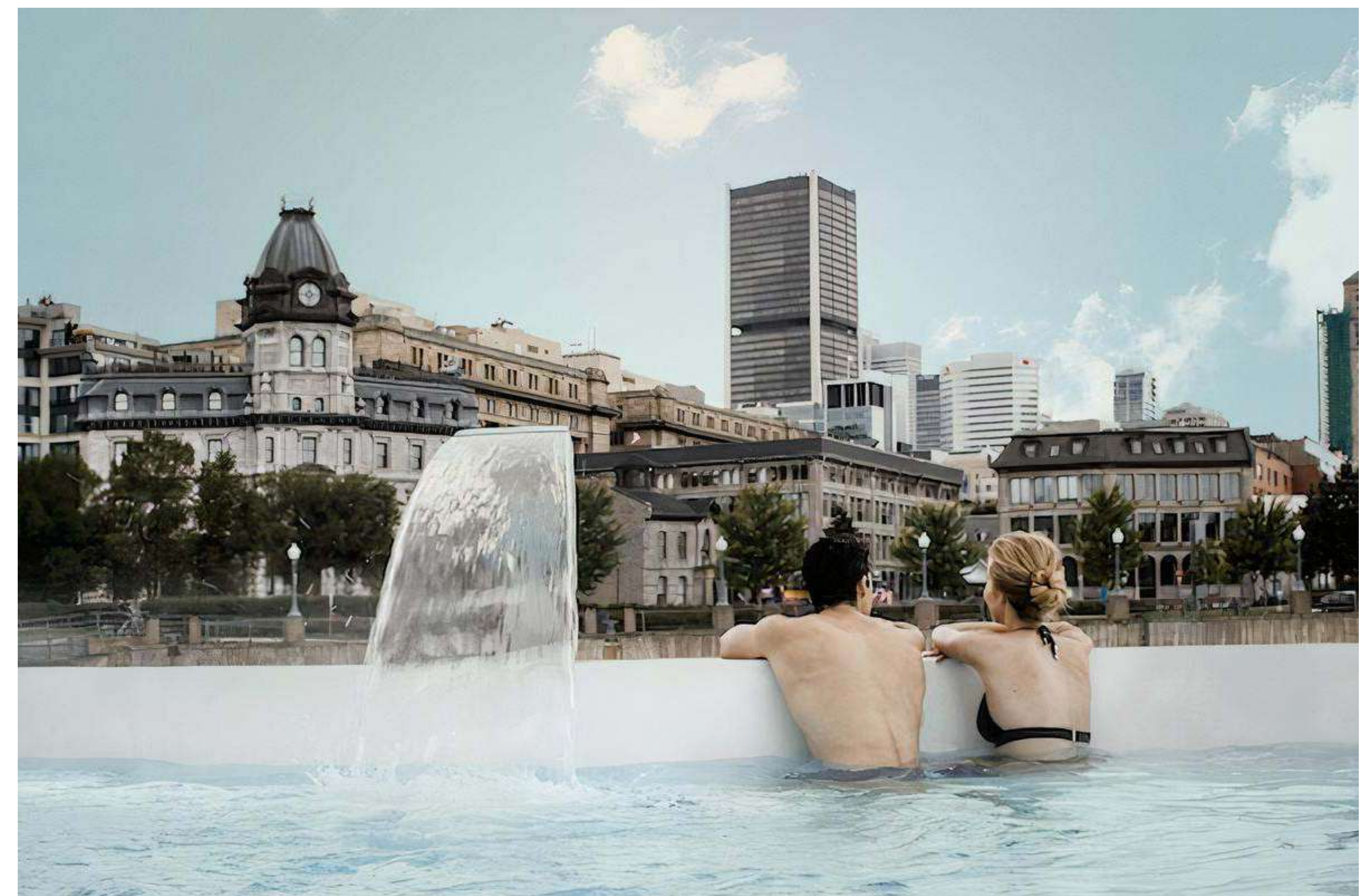
Experience Quebec's world-renowned contemporary circus show in the city where it was born, featuring dazzling acrobatics, storytelling, and artistry under the Big Top.

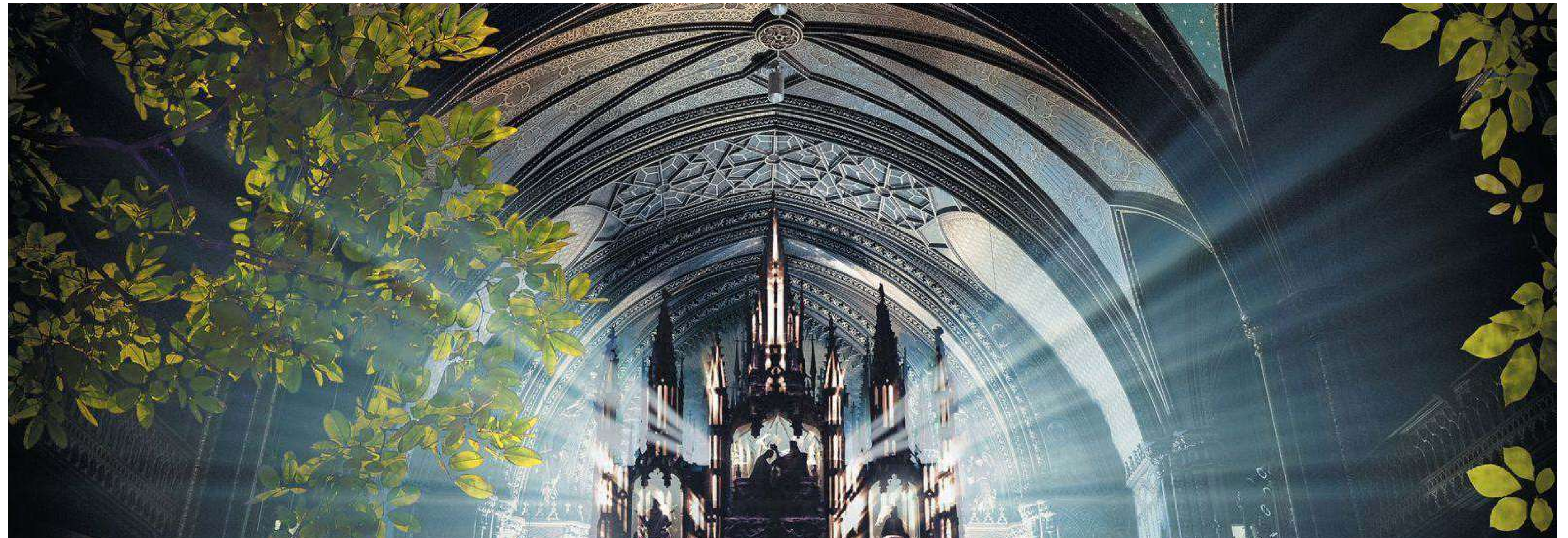
Additional Activities & Attractions
