

CAI COMMITTEE

The CAI Committee makes decisions regarding scheduling, marketing and curriculum for CAI. They also work onsite to advise classes and ensure the program runs smoothly. The CAI Committee meets once during the year away from CAI and may have multiple conference calls. The CAI also reviews and scores the interstitial projects involved in CAI.

Committee Composition
