

IAC LIVE COMMITTEE

The purpose of the NAA IAC Live Committee is to plan and deliver a live, web-streamed broadcast of the IAC contest.

This committee is charged with reviewing the most recently concluded broadcast to identify what worked well and to identify potential areas of improvement. The committee will take this information to plan and deliver a full-day of streaming broadcasts for the IAC contest.

Committee Composition

- The IAC Live Committee will consist of the IAC Chair, a Vice Chair and two to four member volunteers. The NAA Director of Communications will serve as the staff liaison.
- Members will serve two-year terms. The committee reserves the right to request the Executive Committee to fill a vacancy if necessary.
- The Chair and Vice Chair will report to the Board.

Committee Competencies

The following competencies have been identified for those who serve on this committee:

- Process-oriented
- Analytical thinking
- Team-oriented
- General working knowledge of broadcasting and entertainment
- Objective thinking and decision-making skills

The committee will conduct their business through Conference Calls. Committee members will be required to attend the IAC Live Broadcast in person at their own expense.
