FREE QuickBooks Online for a year for students and client businesses

Intuit's Educator Portal Platform, enables NACCE members to give QuickBooks Online (QBO) access to their students and clients, for free, for a full year. Just follow these steps:

- 1) <u>Create an account</u> with Intuit to gain access to the Educator Dashboard. (Just make sure to use the email associated with your NACCE profile.)
- 2) Once you login to the Dashboard, you need to "+Add a Class"
- 3) Once you have created a class, you can add students, and send them an email invite through the dashboard to provide them with QBO access for one year.
