Earn up to 29 college credits for BCCC!



- Enroll at BCCC

29 credits (from HS) & 31-33 (at BCCC) =

Take at least 60 credits into  
Bloomsburg University!



- Carry 60 credits to Bloomsburg University (BU)
- Take additional 60 credits through BU
  - On-site, on-line, blended
  - Some offered at BCCC
