PROPOSAL AND PRESENTATION LIMITS

You may submit up to 3 proposals as the lead presenter. In the final program, an individual can participate in up to 3 presentations. This rule does not apply to NAGC Signature Series or Network Super Sunday Sessions which are invited presentations developed by the NAGC Convention Program Chair or Network Program Chair. It does include Poster Sessions.

PROPOSAL DESIGN AND ABSTRACT

The NAGC Annual Convention aims to present the most high-quality, relevant, and timely content for participants. Sessions are organized into [16 Different Network Strands and 1 NEW Strand: Growing Talent in the Gen Ed Classroom](#). We encourage potential presenters to review the descriptions to find the best match for your proposed session. Proposals require the following components:

1. Indication of **intended Network** (see network descriptions)
2. A **title and 60-word description** that describe the session content to convention attendees.
3. A **250-word, more detailed description** to support proposal evaluation. This description should include more information such as background evidence underlying the session, connections to standards, knowledge and tools that participants will engage with and take away, and/or applications for a specific audience. We encourage direct reference to the [NAGC PreK - Grade 12 Standards](#) and/or to the literature supporting the session. Parenthetical citations are encouraged, but full citations are not required.
4. Responses to a few **additional questions** regarding intended audience, session format, and level of background expected of the audience (introductory/intermediate), and connection to the NAGC

Please take a moment to review the rubric. Network Program Chairs and National Convention Committee members finalize the selections to ensure the process is fair, balanced, and broadly representative of the field. You will receive notice via email in mid-May 2026 regarding the status of your proposal submission(s).

Arts
The Arts Network welcomes proposals about educating those who are gifted and talented in the arts, connecting educational theory, research, and practice in arts disciplines such as creative writing, dance, media arts, music, theater, and visual arts. General examples of appropriate types of proposals include (1) strategies and resources for identification, teaching, counseling, coaching, and mentoring gifted and talented children and youth in the arts, (2) approaches that increase equity and access to advanced arts education opportunities for underrepresented groups, (3) arts integration models that include arts learning objectives and benefit the learners gifted in the arts, (4) talent development models and their application to the arts.

Computers & Technology
Network presentation should help teachers, schools, and parents leverage technology to create optimum environments and learning opportunities for gifted learners. The network would like to offer sessions that span the continuum of audience needs, from beginners to more to the highly experienced participants.

NEW: Growing Talent in the Gen Ed Classroom

Gifted children spend much of their time in general education classrooms where teachers often have little or no specialized training in identifying and serving students of high potential. This strand seeks to extend understanding of gifted education and gifted children to a specific audience: general education classroom teachers. Share strategies, practices, and pedagogies that teachers can employ in the classroom to ensure positive outcomes for all students.
