


Federal Impacts on Nonprofits

November 2025

In response to unprecedented federal funding cuts and numerous Executive Orders (EOs), the Nonprofit Association of the Midlands (NAM), the state association for charitable nonprofits in Nebraska, surveyed nonprofits to understand the impact on the vital work of community-based organizations across the state. NAM will continue polling nonprofit organizations monthly to track ongoing changes in the sector.

Survey Specifics: This survey was open from November 3rd to 19th and received responses from 47 participants. The top three organizational types represented were Human Services, Arts, Culture and Humanities, and Health. Most respondents are based in Nebraska's urban centers of Omaha and Lincoln, with additional representation from mid-size cities in Nebraska as well as Iowa.
