What is I-Corps?


Experiential NSF program prepares scientists and engineers to extend their focus beyond the laboratory.

4 Reasons to Replace Nasal Swabs With

microwash nasal sampling



Higher-Sensitivity Samples

Independent academic research shows up to **49% greater sensitivity** in PCR testing compared to nasal swabs.



Safe & Simple to Use

Decreases clinician infection risk and is more easily and reliably administered compared to nasal swabs.







Shelf-Stable

Has a **three-year shelf life**, while nasal swab kits generally expire after one to two years.



Comfortable

Alleviates fear and anxiety that may lead to test avoidance with a 0.3/10 patient pain rating, compared to nasal swabs at 8/10.

PROBLEM - SOLUTION - HYPOTHESIS

Problem

Current viral testing solutions are invasive and painful

Solution

The Microwash eliminates the need for a swab in the nose and instead use a simple nasal lavage

Hypothesis

Customers rate current swab methods between 7-10 on a pain Likert scale

Customers would pay more for a method that would allow them to avoid the swab method


