LET'S TAKE A TRIP AROUND THE CAPITOL




COMMITTEE HEARING

A senator introduces the bill and the committee holds a public hearing.

COMMITTEE MEETS IN AN EXECUTIVE SESSION

In a closed door meeting, the committee votes to

advance, hold or kill the bill



1ST ROUND OF DEBATE: GENERAL FILE

The senator introduces the bill on the floor and the senators debate

REVISE & AMEND

Senators may draft amendments to revise the bill.




2ND ROUND OF DEBATE: SELECT FILE

Bill returns to the unicameral floor and senators debate

3RD ROUND OF DEBATE: FINAL READING

The entire bill is read aloud and then senators **vote to pass or fail**



THE GOVERNOR DECIDES

They can **sign**, **decline to sign**, **or veto** the bill.

A vetoed bill returns to the legislature for a chance at a **veto override**.

BILL BECOMES A LAW

If the governor signs the bill, declines to sign but doesn't veto, or a veto is overridden, the bill becomes a law! It will go into effect within 3 months.
