- 2. Thinking of work you do outside of your 'day job' (volunteer activities, board service, etc) past & present, what is most significant or meaningful to you? Why?
- 3. What is currently your greatest professional challenge?

Future Vision

- 1. What is your vision for your professional future? Where do you see yourself in three to five years? How will NEI help you achieve your goals?
- 2. What current trends and emerging issues will impact your work in the next 3-5 years, either positively or negatively?

Professional Growth

- 1. How do you invest in yourself? What other professional development experiences have you had? How do you stay current on emerging trends, best practices, or other developments in your field?
- What is a unique skill, perspective, or strength that you would bring to the group?
