# Letter from the Board President Michelle Zych and CEO Anne Hindery

How many times have you heard '2020, what a year?' Probably way too often but 2020 was one for the record books. A year ago, COVID-19 spread across the world and our communities. As the reality set in that the pandemic was going to be a long haul, nonprofits led the way in developing innovative solutions to ensure that their crucial missions and services continued to meet the needs of our communities. As spring turned to summer, then fall and winter, nonprofits continue to rise to the occasion to deal with the multiple crises of the pandemic, resulting economic recession, and racial inequity.

The unprecedented and much-needed attention 2020 brought to the systemic oppression experienced by our BIPOC communities led many of us, including NAM, to look inward. After sharing resources to strengthen nonprofits ability to support their staff and the communities they serve, NAM made the decision to add social policy to our advocacy agenda for the first time. We are proud to work in partnership with others to continue to move NAM and the nonprofit sector forward in anti-oppression work.

The mission at the Nonprofit Association of the Midlands (NAM) is to strengthen the collective voice, leadership, and capacity of nonprofit organizations to enrich the quality of community life throughout Nebraska and Western Iowa. As the organization that serves nonprofits of all sizes and missions, we took a breath to ask ourselves "what type of organization do our members need us to be right now?" The answer we found was to advocate for resources for all nonprofits, regardless of membership, and to share critical (and ever-changing) information on the CARES Act. To continue to better understand the needs of our nonprofit community, we conducted PULSE Polls and provided ongoing training opportunities to keep up with the everchanging environment that was 2020.

We know that nonprofits are vital to our economy and our communities. As we move into the next normal, nonprofits will continue to contribute to our nation's relief, recovery, and rebuilding. NAM is here to help you do that.

We are incredibly grateful to our generous supporters, board members and the team at NAM for making this year possible. A special thank you to our nonprofit member organizations. It is your work that creates the community fabric that is essential to our quality of life.

### **Guidelines and Principles**

The Guidelines and Principles for Nonprofit Excellence (G&P) is a toolkit that supports the efficiency, transparency & accountability of nonprofits in Nebraska and Iowa. The G&P provides an online assessment that helps nonprofits of all sizes and missions strengthen their business infrastructure so they can concentrate on their important mission. The purpose of the Guidelines and Principles is threefold: 1) to provide nonprofit organizations a state-specific tool to evaluate compliance, enhance strategic planning, and refine operations; 2) to support the growth and quality of the sector; and 3) to increase the public's understanding of the role and value of the nonprofit sector.

### **NAM's Training**

As with everything, NAM's training calendar changed drastically in 2020, some highlights included:

- Added 'Just in Time' training series in response to rapidly changing environment in 2020. Topics included the CARES Act, public health updates, cash flow planning, working from home tips, fundraising in a crisis, self-care, adapting to remote work, managing teams remotely, tips for using Zoom, and other timely topics.
- Thanks to generous sponsors, NAM was able to offer nearly \$50,000 worth of free & reduced cost training to ensure all nonprofits had access to needed information during uncertain times.
- · Grant Writing Palooza was offered virtually for the first time. 111 people participated.
- Other training topics included diversity, equity and inclusion, nonprofit finance, human resources, board governance, marketing, IT, program evaluation & strategic planning.
- Registrations for NAM trainings in 2020 totaled 2,974





### **Membership**





NAM ended 2020 with 666 members, up from 638 in 2019.

### **Nonprofit Salary & Benefit Report**

NAM's Salary and Benefit survey is the most comprehensive in the Nebraska and western lowa region. The survey and related report may be used to develop internal benchmarks for nonprofits to attract and retain talent. It is of note that the survey was in the field at the same time the COVID-19 pandemic hit the region.

332 nonprofit organizations participated in the 2020 Nonprofit Salary and Benefit Survey up from 290 participants in 2019. Participants are most often small to moderately sized nonprofits: 64% were from the Omaha Metropolitan area and most were NAM members. Data was collected on 97 unique jobs across 13 job families and 6 career levels for analysis of salaries, compensation practices and benefits. 2020 report and participants can be found **HERE**.

### **Public Policy**

NAM continued its policy work in 2020 with a specific focus on COVID relief packages for nonprofits. NAM knows that nonprofits are the backbone of our community and are needed now more than ever. We strongly advocated for and educated our members on elements of the CARES Act including adjustments to unemployment benefits, nonprofit specific Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loans, nonprofits being included in Small Business Administration (SBA) loans, and strengthening charitable giving incentives. NAM looks forward to continuing to advocate for these at the federal level. NAM also conducted three Pulse Polls to gauge where nonprofits were at during the pandemic. ### **Financial Services Program**

NAM has been providing NAM Financial Services for three years now and has assisted over 70 nonprofits with accounting needs. The program has approximately 45 active clients utilizing services that range from processing and printing checks, to setting up and recording payroll activity, to reconciling bank accounts and preparing financial reports for management and board. This program is customized to each individual nonprofit, and the level of NAM involvement depends on the needs of each client.

The NAM 403(b) plan offers nonprofit organizations an affordable way to provide retirement benefits.

More than 75 nonprofit organizations offer retirement benefits through NAM's 403b retirements plan, which has over \$37M in assets.


