Guidelines and Principles

The Guidelines and Principles for Nonprofit Excellence (G&P) is a toolkit that supports the efficiency, transparency & accountability of nonprofits in Nebraska and Iowa. The G&P provides an online assessment that helps nonprofits of all sizes and missions strengthen their business infrastructure so they can concentrate on their important mission. The purpose of the Guidelines and Principles is threefold: 1) to provide nonprofit organizations a state-specific tool to evaluate compliance, enhance strategic planning, and refine operations; 2) to support the growth and quality of the sector; and 3) to increase the public's understanding of the role and value of the nonprofit sector

532 organizations used the Guidelines & Principles to enhance their organizational infrastructure and plan for the future in 2021.

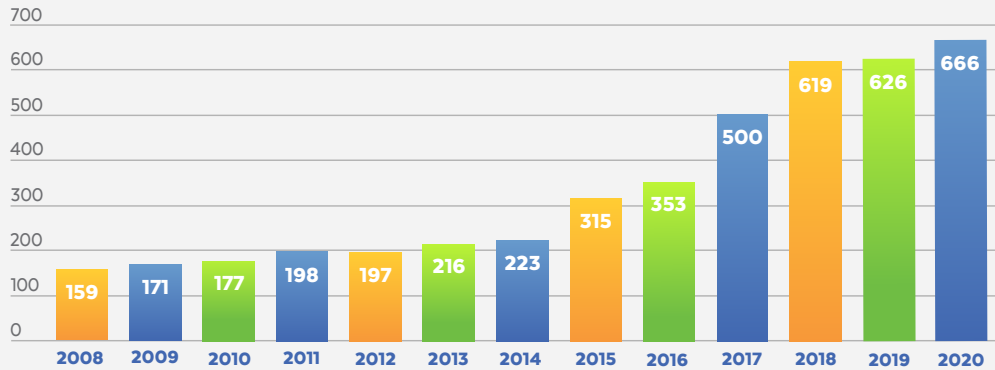

Membership

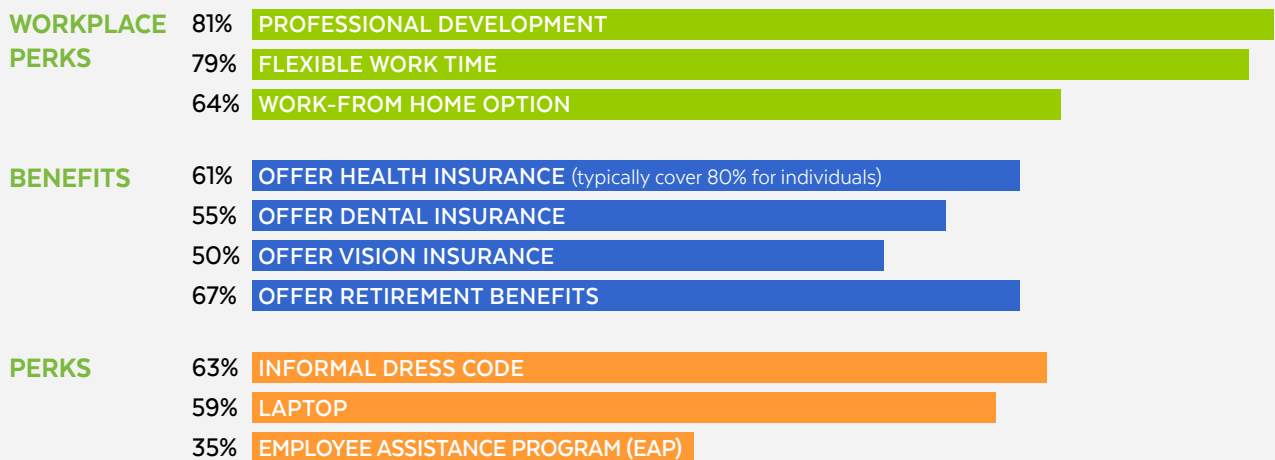
Membership grew from 692 in January 2021 to 750 in December 2021, an 8.4% increase.



Nonprofit Salary & Benefit Report

The 2021 Nonprofit Salary & Benefits Report was made available to members in May of 2021. The report contained salary and benefit information on 97 jobs codes and ran to 197 pages. There were 333 nonprofit participants who contributed to the report. To date, 185 organizations have purchased the report.

The 2022 Nonprofit Salary & Benefits Survey is in the field as of the writing of this report. The full report is intended to be available to members and all other nonprofits in May 2022.





Public Policy

NNAM continued its policy work in 2021 with a specific focus on the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and making sure nonprofits are at the table deciding how these transformational dollars will be spent in Nebraska. NAM facilitated three ARPA Roundtables with over 300 participants to narrow down recommendations on where ARPA dollars should go into the categories of Early Childhood, Food, Health, Housing, and Workforce. NAM knows that nonprofits are the backbone of our community and are needed now more than ever. NAM looks forward to continuing to advocate for charitable giving incentives and other important issues on the federal level. Policy agenda can be found [HERE](#).

Financial Services Program

Financial Services Program NAM has been providing NAM Financial Services for four years now and has assisted over 100 nonprofits with accounting needs. The program has approximately 55 active clients utilizing services that range from processing and printing checks, to setting up and recording payroll activity, to reconciling bank accounts and preparing financial reports for management and board. This program is customized to each individual nonprofit, and the level of NAM involvement depends on the needs of each client.

403(b) Retirement Plan

The NAM 403b Retirement Plan provided with our partners FNIC, continues to grow to serve nonprofit employees. At the time of this writing the 403b plan at NAM has 80 employers with 2,028 employees contributing. The assets under management are over \$42.5M.

Employee Assistance Program

The NAM Employee Assistance Program helps nonprofit employees manage stress, build resilience, and deal with potential mental health problems. The NAM EAP has 48 employers enrolled serving 986 employees!
