Project Scope and Objectives

This project began with an owner's suite that no longer worked for the homeowners' lifestyle. Storage was limited, the bathroom felt closed off, and the overall look didn't reflect the elegance of the rest of their remodeled home. Together, we set out to create a suite that was both modern and welcoming—one that balanced style with everyday comfort. The bathroom was reimagined with an open layout for better flow and accessibility, while the bedroom was designed to be a calming retreat with thoughtful details for each of the homeowners. The result is a primary suite that feels spacious, personalized, and fully in step with the rest of their home.

Challenges and Solutions

One of the first challenges was finding a way to divide the bedroom without altering the structure of the home. By building inward, we created the illusion of a reading nook–giving the homeowners a cozy retreat within the suite while keeping the footprint intact.


The bathroom layout presented another opportunity. While the original design was workable, it lacked the space needed for the new shower. By carefully enlarging the bathroom, we made room for a more generous shower complete with a built-in bench for comfort and relaxation.

To address storage, we designed cabinetry and shelving that blended seamlessly into the architecture. Built-ins in the reading nook provide a natural home for books, while recessed shelves around the vanity keep everyday items within easy reach. Each detail was crafted to maximize function while maintaining a sense of calm and continuity throughout the suite.


Results

The finished suite feels both cohesive and elevated, seamlessly aligning with the rest of the home. The bedroom now includes a bright, inviting reading nook that offers a quiet retreat without requiring structural changes, framed by detailed millwork that enhances its modern traditional style. In the bathroom, the reconfigured layout made room for a spacious shower with a built-in bench—an everyday luxury designed for comfort.

Storage was carefully woven into the design, from recessed shelves around the vanity to built-in bookshelves in the reading nook, keeping essentials organized without interrupting the flow of the space. Arched openings over the nook, entry, and bathtub add subtle architectural detail, giving the suite a sense of character and charm. The result is a personalized retreat that blends style, function, and warmth–exceeding what the homeowners had imagined.
