design statement

This project is an example of a true collaboration between client and designer. It is somewhat rare to get the opportunity to work with a client who loves art, color, and design as much as you do, but this is how it turned out. You will notice a couple themes as we walk you through this project, and they are function, color, and whimsy. This home is anything but boring, just like those who reside here. This remodel took a kitchen that was literally breaking down and made it this hostess' dream kitchen. A bathroom that was small, dingy, and dark now feels like an art gallery. And the laundry room (which doubles as the everyday entrance to this home) went from treacherous and worn, to classic and cool.

- As a collector of art of all kinds, carefully thought-out art lighting would be incorporated to multiple rooms throughout the home.










challenge alert!

When beginning work on this one-level rambler, we were surprised to find out the wall we planned to remove turned out to be structural! Unbeknownst to us, the roof rafters switched directions in that location and would drive us to install a new flush structural header to keep the floorplan the same.

The old kitchen island offered very little function. The cooktop in the middle of it was barely functioning and there was very little workspace left and right of it. The large island hood made the room feel small and blocked sightlines.

In the new kitchen layout, the cooktop is now on this back wall providing an absolutely stunning focal point in the space. Custom ombre tile in a hand-selected color scheme make this backsplash truly one of a kind. This feature was made possible by the true artists at Mercury Mosaics, a local tile manufacturer. The colors that were selected were inspired by art pieces that would be displayed in the finished space.

By removing the wall between the kitchen and dining room, this hostess' expansive dining room table now has much better flow when filled with guests. By extending the kitchen cabinetry into this space, that area can be utilized as a bar or buffet when entertaining.

These gallery cubbies were custom designed, pulling in our bold color scheme, and intended to house the aforementioned-inspirational art pieces. A custom spot for the TV was also carefully planned.

The style of cabinetry and other kitchen materials were also selected with that in mind.





This space is also heavily used by the pets in this home, so durability was a top priority. The stairs were reframed to make them less steep and easier to enter the home gracefully. A sleek custom iron railing offers stability and safety. New Luxury Vinyl stair treads tie in the existing woodwork and original cabinets that we were sure to maintain in the new design. A deep terrazzo style tile floor is a great feature and offers maximum durability. Pops of color and a funky LED light make this laundry room feel super fun and ultra unique.
