
**PROJECT: MIDWEST LAKE HOME** 

**CATEGORY:** ENTIRE HOUSE OVER \$1M

Our client wished to remodel this 1980 house to create a multigenerational home, lakeside retreat, and art gallery. Skylights were installed with exposed collar ties to create light wells and an airy space streaming in natural light. A translucent polycarbonate floor floats atop a slatted entry ceiling to hold a Fir-paneled meditation room that casts shadows as the sun passes. Our client's design skills contributed to multiple artistic features, both modest and eyecatching, that inspire subtle details throughout the home. A screen porch was added on the lakeside for plein air dining. New triple-pane windows flood the home with light and open views to the lake and trees on the wooded property. White Ash floors throughout, two built-in Basswood benches, and two free-standing Oak tables are an homage to the trees that had to be removed from the property. Hinoki shoji screens and a Japanese ofuro tub enhance the tranquil atmosphere in this space. This project is the culmination of architectural design, artistic vision, a distinctive zen aesthetic, and a collaborative approach to building that has created myriad spaces that will bring this family joy for generations to come.












## MAIN LEVEL DEMO PLAN




### MAIN LEVEL FLOOR PLAN
